The Next Steps in the Process and Construction.

- Obtain final approval from the Town of Somerville for the overall Site Plan.
- Submit the project to the Design Review Commission (DRC) and the Architect will attend the DRC meeting for approval.
- Architect will review final drawings and construction specifications to be included in the contractor bid packages with the St. Philip Building Committee.
- Obtain final approval of plans from the Diocese of Memphis.
- Establish a deadline for the General Contractors to submit bids. (Usually 3 weeks later).
- Send Construction Documents and Specifications to General Contractors inviting them to bid on the project.
- Submit a copy of the bid Package to the Town of Somerville for their review prior to issuing the building permit.
- Architect will review the submitted bids to ensure that all specifications have been met, and then will recommend a General Contractor, with justification for their recommendation.
- Owner/Contractor Agreement will be negotiated, if necessary, and signed.
- Construction Starts.

(As this process plays out and we will keep you informed of the timeline and dates.)
