The applicant must be...

- An active and practicing Catholic communicant at Saint Philip, The Apostle Catholic Church
- in good standing in the Diocese of Memphis
- A graduating senior entering a 2- or 4-year college, or trade school ...OR
- A youth member of Saint Philip the Apostle Catholic Church Parish entering grades 9 – 12, at any local school

Candidates will be judged on the following:

- Active and practicing Catholic at Saint Philip participating in church activities
- Community Service performed at church and community, with documented community service
- Grade point average and school activities
- A 5-paragraph essay on the importance of Christianity in Today's World and what this scholarship means to candidate and how it will be used

Applications:

- Must include 2 recommendations; teacher, non-family member, adult
- Will be accepted between January 15<sup>th</sup> and March 15<sup>th</sup>
- Deadline is NO later than March 15<sup>th</sup> of each year
- Scholarship(s) will be awarded on April 15<sup>th</sup>

Scholarship Program Rules/ Recipient Rights and Obligations:

- Applicants may reapply for consideration each year, if not selected. If applicant received award during grades 9-12, applicant may reapply before entering college or trade school
- Scholarship recipients authorize Council 14482 to post their name, picture, and brief description of award recipient.
- Council 14482 will seek recipient's permission if any additional application information is requested for publishing.
